As part of the year-long Mega Medical Camp, the Indian Community Relief Fund (ICRF) has organised its eighth camp at the Kims Health Medical Centre in Asker.

Blood tests were conducted for around 175 workers followed by medical checkups and consultations by Dr Muhammad Zubair and Dr Taimoor Asif.

This is the 8th Mega Medical Camp and as part of this programme nearly 1,100 workers underwent health screening at various hospitals so far.

Bahraini retiree jailed for fraud

The High Criminal Court sentenced a Bahraini retiree accused of fraud to three years in jail.

The defendant reportedly managed to con his friends out of more than \$100,000 after deceiving them that he was an expert in investing money in international bourses and several marine companies as well as foodstuff establishments.

The scam was discovered after the time to distribute incentives arrived as he informed them that he lost all the investments. The victims filed a complaint at the police to them, but I need some time," he said.

"We used to meet him at a restaurant in Manama. He discussed with his investments and his returns through investing in international bourses and foodstuff companies," one of the victims told prosecutors.

"He used special business terms. Thus, we trusted his expertise and we gave him money. He took from us initially \$10,000 from each one. He gave us \$10,000 as profits," he added.
